# Overweight Corridor Locations



The Hidalgo County Regional Mobility Authority (HCRMA) administers the overweight permit corridor system for the Hidalgo County. Overweight permits issued through the HCRMA are only valid for destinations originating from the following points of entry:

- Anzalduas Bridge
- Pharr-Reynosa Bridge
- Donna-Rio Bravo Bridge
- Progreso Bridge
- Or 15 Corridor Segments

At this time, we do not have a connecting route from Hidalgo County to Cameron County. Traveling beyond the approved corridor may result in penalties and fines.

# Permit Application Requirements

- Gross Weight  $\leq$  125,000 lbs
  - Maximum Weight limit per Axle
    - Single Axel 25,000 lbs
    - Tandem Axel 46,000 lbs
    - Tridem Axel 60,000 lbs
- Dimensions of Load < 12ft wide, 16ft high, or 110ft long
- Certified Scale Ticket = Weight on Permit

- Permits good for 24 hours after activation
  - Overweight: 24/7
  - Oversized: Daylight Hours

# Allowed Commodities

*All legal commodities are allowed to be transported*

- Driver must be aware of the following: may not exceed the posted speed limit or 55 miles per hour, whichever is less.
  - Cannot deviate from designated route.
  - Follows rules to weather conditions or road work. Movement of a permitted vehicle is prohibited when:
    - visibility is reduced to less than 2/10 of one mile;
    - the road surface is hazardous due to weather conditions, such as rain, ice, sleet, or snow; or
    - highway maintenance or construction work is being performed.
- Daylight and night movement restrictions. An oversize permitted vehicle may be moved only during daylight hours. A permitted vehicle that is overweight but not oversize may be moved at any time.

# USDOT Information Before Creating Accounts or Entering Permits

## Broker Only:

- As a broker it is your responsibility to verify that your customer has active USDOT Number for every account they create or for any permits issued.
- It is important for Brokers to verify active USDOT status. Failing to do so can result suspension or inactivation of the brokers account to issue overweight/oversize permits.

Welcome to the Hidalgo County overweight permit system. You will find a brief description of the various features offered by this website below.

### **Vehicles**

The Vehicles pages allows you to create and modify trucks and trailers for use in permit applications. This allows you to simply select an existing truck and trailer when applying for a permit, rather than entering truck and trailer information manually during the permit application process.

### **Order Permits**

The Order Permits page walks you through the process of purchasing a permit. Permits may be paid for by credit card or through an escrow account.

### **Search Permits**

The Search Permits page allows you to search all the permits you have purchased in order to quickly locate a specific permit.

### **View All Permits**

The View All Permits page allows you to view all the permits you have purchased with links to edit the permit information as well as links to view a PDF version of the actual permit.

### **Company Information**

The Company Information page allows you to modify your company details such as address, contact information, and password.

### **Escrow**

The Escrow page allows you to view a history of Escrow transactions if you have chosen to utilize the Escrow account system.

Once you have access to your account, you have the option to enter your vehicle inventory.

If you are a broker you will have access to all accounts. If information is not correct you have access to edit all vehicles.



A tandem truck has single axle in the front and a double axle in the rear. Because there are two wheels placed on each side of the truck's rear axle, the weight carried on the truck bed can be evenly distributed.

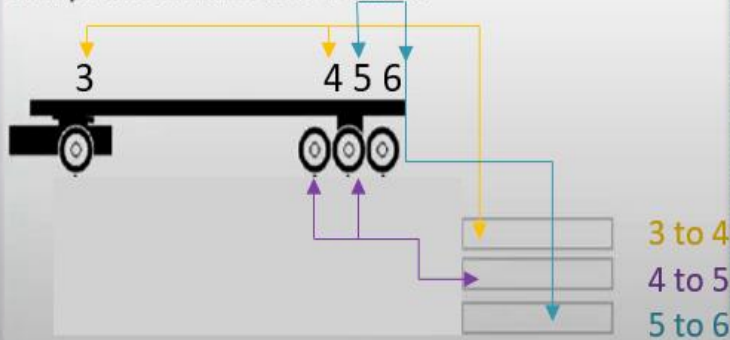

Remember, that the weight has to be distributed according to the amount of axis your truck/trailer have. No more than 125,000 pounds of overweight is allowed.

Additionally, the weight allowed is per axle count and the allowable weight limit. It is not based on total weight allowable to carry on your vehicle. Make sure you know how many axels you have and what the legal limit of weight per axle.

## NOTICE:

As of 12/18/2023 you will be required to enter the loaded dimensions.

Maximum Load Size allowed is:

Load Width: 12 feet

Load Height: 16 feet

Load Length: 110 feet.

System will only allow you to enter like example.

**Example: 82ft4in**

Load width is measured by indicating the largest. Either Truck or trailer (not counting mirrors). If your load is bigger or wider than both your truck and trailer you will have to take measurement from the load width. Enter dimension. Your maximum allowable width can only be 12 feet. Abbreviate feet to ft when entering into the permit system as shown above.

Load height is measured as the tallest part of your truck or trailer. If your load is higher than both your truck and trailer you will have to use load height. The maximum allowable height is 16 feet.

Load length is measured from bumper of truck to the end of the trailer. Your maximum allowable length is 110 feet.

# Let's Review

There are only fifteen oversize/overweight routes in Hidalgo County that can be selected for permit. The driver can't deviate from those routes. To avoid citations/fines always try to buy the route closest to your destination.

Weight must be distributed correctly and efficiently across all axles of your vehicle. The maximum amount of weight is 125,000 pounds or no more than the legal Mexican peso limit.

Certified scale ticket must have the same information as on the weight on permit. The certified weight scale has to be purchased for each load. You can't use the same certified weight scale ticket for another load.

Remember! You can't add more weight to the load after the permits have been generated because if the driver is stopped by DPS, they will be fined.

When requesting a permit, you must ensure that all information entered is correct. Vehicle information includes unit number, vin number, make, license plate number, driver information, weight and destination. Enter VIN number correctly. Please verify VIN with your Tarjeta De Circulacion or Title. Remember you have access to edit your vehicle information. Not verifying the VIN number and entering it incorrectly will only cause your account to be inactivated



# Let's Review

It is recommended to wait until the driver is ready to leave before issuing the permit. Sometimes permits are entered in advance and then they realize that the truck has broken down, We will not be able to reset the permits.

You only have 24 hours from the date and time indicated on the permit. The driver may be fined if the permit date/time has expired.

On the payment information screen, you must review the permit order before submitting for payment. We strongly recommend that you review all the information. Once you've reviewed, you can select Submit Order.

Please press the "Submit" button only once. You should not double-click the "Submit" button. If a double click is done, the permit will duplicate. Sometimes the system will take a while and you will notice a blue spinning symbol which is indicating that your computer is slow due to a virus, window blockers, or slow internet connectivity. Please be patient and wait for the system to process the payment.

Please remember that permits will not be reset due to an error on the part of the company purchasing the permit. It is your responsibility to enter all correct information.
